

We are the guests of Louisiana State University during our resident session. As with all visiting groups, we are expected to conform to LSU's rules and regulations. GSB operates with as few of its own rules as possible, but students and faculty are reminded of the following guidelines:

1. Punctual attendance at all assigned classes, prep sessions, case studies, evening lectures, and other announced assignments is required. There are no unexcused absences. In case of illness or emergency, contact someone in the GSB administration directly or through the GSB desk at East Campus Apartments.
2. The University is a smoke-free and tobacco-free campus, indoors and out.
3. Observe campus parking and traffic regulations, which are posted in the ECA Activity Center, Room 2.
4. We cannot condone impoliteness in class, lack of consideration for others, or other unacceptable behavior. You are asked to turn off your cell phone and any other electronic device while in the classroom.
5. While LSU rules do not permit alcoholic beverages in apartments, the University has been lenient in enforcing this with adult groups. However, such beverages must NOT be consumed in public areas such as the ECA Activity Center and the common areas outside the ECA apartments.
6. The Graduate School of Banking is not a convention. Correspondent banking activities of any kind are not permissible.
