Lodging

Room assignments are made prior to registration. You will receive a memo indicating your housing and elective assignments prior to your arrival on campus. Apartments will be available for occupancy beginning at **9:00am Monday, May 25, through Noon on Friday, June 5.**

The School furnishes a pillow, pillowcase, set of sheets, and a lightweight blanket. A supply of 5 towels and 10 washcloths is provided along with detergent to launder these as needed. LSU housekeeping staff will enter the apartments daily to clean the bathrooms and make beds; bed linens will be changed on Friday only. **Many students bring a twin mattress topper for extra comfort.**

Each bedroom maintains its own locking system. GSB is not responsible for any lost items, computers, etc. left in your apartment.

Each apartment has a kitchen with a refrigerator, stove, microwave, dishwasher, and garbage disposal. No detergent, kitchenware or utensils are provided. The School does **NOT** furnish an alarm clock, telephone, television, iron, or hair dryer. Each apartment has a clothes washer and dryer; detergent is provided to launder towels. Additional detergent should be brought for your personal use. Each bedroom has a basic cable TV jack and Ethernet data connection. If you bring a TV, you must also bring the cable for connection. You should also bring your cell phone and charger.

Clothing

Casual dress (jeans, slacks, t-shirts, walking shorts, tennis shoes, sandals) is suitable attire for all class lectures and official assemblies, **except for graduation**. The median temperature in Baton Rouge in May is 80 degrees, and the average rainfall is about 4 inches. It is advisable to bring lightweight clothing and a raincoat or umbrella.

Back Packs

Arrival on Campus—Monday, May 25

Parking

Spaces are available around the apartments and across from the BEC (Business Education Complex) and PFT (Patrick F. Taylor building). Permits for parking only in apartment/BEC & PFT lots are available at registration, and should be placed on the rear view mirror. Violators will be ticketed by Campus Security, and violations will normally result in a \$50 fine payable at the Office of the Bursar. Cars parked in unauthorized areas will be towed away at the owner's expense. Parking is limited on campus, but you are allowed to park across the street from your classes in the BEC and PFT buildings this year. If you have a bicycle on campus, you should bring a bicycle lock.

Registration

Registration begins at 9:00am on Monday, May 25. Upon arrival on the LSU campus, **ALL students will check in at the Nora Power ACTIVITY BUILDING at East Campus Apts.** Go to Room #2 (GSB desk) where you will receive your schedule and nametag. Freshmen will also pick up a backpack. **HANG ONTO YOUR KEYS.** The charge for replacing a lost apartment bedroom key is \$80.

Email/Internet Access

Wireless access to the Internet can be received in your apartment living area, bedroom, and common areas. An Internet connection is also available in your bedroom. Your computer must have an Ethernet adapter, and you need a Category 6 (CAT6) cable to connect from your computer to the outlet. Make sure your computer is set to obtain an IP address automatically. Instructions to connect your computer to the LSU Network for an Internet connection, including username/password are found on General Information page on gsblsu.org under Computer Users' Responsibilities.

Nametags

Nametags are issued at registration and should be worn at all times. They are required for admission to classes, meals and athletic facilities. The color scheme used is:

- **Blue** ----- Seniors
- **Red** ----- Juniors
- **Green** ----- Freshmen

Food Services

The School will provide food service at "The 459 Commons" Dining Unit (see your LSU campus map). Meal service begins at 5:00 pm Monday, May 25, and continues through breakfast on Friday, June 5. On Friday evening May 29, a school party for students and faculty will be held in the LSU Mini Barn at 6:00pm. During the Session

Recreational Facilities

The Student Recreational Sports Complex will be open on May 25—June 4. The hours are:

Monday - Thursday	5:45am—9:00pm

The fee will be \$35.00 for 1 week; \$50.00 for 2 weeks. You will need to **complete and fax** the University Recreation Form prior to the Session; **fax to the SRSC office**. Once you have arrived at LSU, you will need to go to the University Recreation Guest Services, located in the SRSC, during their registration hours which are listed on the University Recreation Form, to make payment and receive your validated pass.

Jogging—Jogging paths are located around the L.S.U. Lakes.

Golf—The L.S.U. Golf Course and the Golf Range will be open daily. Electric carts and pull carts will be available for rental. Green fees will be charged.

Tennis—Tennis courts are normally open for free play on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Racquetball Courts—Outdoor 3-wall courts (*located near tennis courts*) are usually open for recreational play seven days per week. The Student Recreational Sports Complex will be open for recreational play.

Swimming—The Student Recreational Sports Complex will be available for swimming laps and water basketball.

Messages

During the Session, GSB personnel will be in Room 2 during posted office hours in the ECA Activity Center. Messages will be posted on the dry eraser board in Room 2. Students cannot be called out of class for messages except in case of medical emergency.

LSU personnel will be at the Activity Center's main desk from 7:00am to midnight. After hours, the name and phone # of an "on call" LSU staff member will be posted on the door. Report apartment maintenance or any emergency problem to the LSU front desk at 225-334-4248, or after hours, call the LSU "on call" staff. The doors to the Center will be locked at midnight.

Check Out and Departure

Freshmen and Juniors may depart after their final exams which will conclude by 5:45pm on Thursday evening or Friday morning if they choose.

Seniors are free to leave after 9:00 am graduation exercises which should be concluded by 9:30 am on Friday.

Buses will begin transporting bankers to the BR airport on Friday morning from 7:30am until approximately 11:30am. The East Campus Apartments close at Noon.

ALL STUDENTS must give their name and keys (including plastic key card) to the LSU front desk at the ECA Activity Center. **If your keys are not returned AT CHECK OUT on Thursday/Friday, you will be billed \$80 to replace your bedroom key and/or \$155 to replace your apartment's outside door key or \$170.00 for both keys.**

Students are provided with extra garbage bags which should be used to empty the refrigerator, discard any personal bedding, toiletries, etc. that are frequently left at the end of each session. LSU cannot donate these discarded items. All items should be removed as LSU will charge \$50 per bedroom if the apartment is not like you found it. Dumpsters and recycle bins are available around the complex for your use.
